This started with a discussion of the Beatty Bike Park build (funded by a RTP grant) and the interaction with CMRP.

CMRP director at Beatty (______) wanted to turn some of the existing trails that TB built into HIKER ONLY trail. Bryan is in conservations with (______) to prevent this from happening. Because of this request from P&R, the start date for construction on the new sections of the trail at Beatty has been pushed back to Fall 2021 (Oct).

Because of this possible change in direction Bryan would like to establish quarterly meetings with CMPR department.

Wanted to know who else would be interested in attending/ being invited. Brian B, Kyle and Tom all indicated they would be interested.

Brian B would like to attend and to see the following specific items achieved by these meetings

- 1. Use of our 5 and 10 year goals included in the their master plan
- 2. Be prepared to ask for money (specific amounts) to get our goals accomplished.

Items that we would like to see discussed during these meeting

Trail Recognition (protection of existing trail and expansion of new trail for MTB).

Trail Funding

Inclusion in P & R Master Plan

Sharing the Clubs master plan (5 and 10 year goals).

Develop and improve existing relationships with P & R staff for the different areas of CM:

Tom working with (Brett ______) concerning parking trail at Airline Bike Park (aka Dixie River). The club has developed a temporary fix but the city needs to find a more permanent solution.

Kyle has been working closely with N Meck P & R to get NM open after the stream project completed (he was scheduled to walk the trails with them the following day).

Bryan working with Beatty staff to get better protection of existing trail and have it added to their master plan.

Mark has been working closely with Davidson P & R also around a stream project.

ACTION ITEMS:

Bryan wants to establish a committee to develop a Master Plan for MTB in the CM metro region. This plan would be something that was professionally done. Therefore funding would be required (grants and/or donations in addition to city participation).

Committee Meeting



First committee meeting was originally scheduled for May meeting but it was decided to held in June to allow more time for the board to be better prepared and give all TC more time to schedule their time. Attendance will be mandatory for all TCs (or their representative). This meeting will most likely be virtual.

Items that were discussed to be on the agenda for this meeting are as follows (but not limited to):. **ACTION:** Mark and Bryan will finalize an agenda for the meeting.

Trail maintenance certification class

Good for 2 years

Each TC or a representative of that trail would need to attend.

Create a fund to support these classes and materials (ie books, teachers, speakers).

Initially to have a professional (or third party) do a train the trainer course, then future classes could be done internally.

Fund for maintaining and adding machines that the club owns

Bike (or other high value item) raffle. (trial run being done for Beatty project).

Annual Trail Plan

Create a form and method of documenting trail work and volunteer work.

Create a method and procedure that TCs would have to go through to get funding for a trail or project (besides normal day to day stuff).

Create a form, procedure or method for TC to perform annual (or regular) inspections of their trails and features. (Mark volunteered to work on this).

Coordinate training of TCs so they can perform the above item.

Try to make signage more uniform throughout the TB trail system.

Create a standard sign package.

Get budget requirements for 2022 budget

Annual plan submitted one to two months before budget is due.

Allows the club to better budget for large scale projects.

Allows for plans to be altered if necessary.

Allows for smaller projects to still get done and supported.

Get information and access to all individual trail's social media outlets (i.e. BYT community FB page, RBP, etc.).

Rocky Branch Park project update (Bruce E.)

Community Foundation Virtual 5k ongoing through Saturday 4/17

Belmont CTT and bridges are complete (0.67 miles).

Green Zone Trail about 1/3 complete.

Blue Zone Trail bid awarded to Nature Trails.

Cramerton CTT awarded to Nature Trails.

Cramerton MOU with GCS final and RBP is extended into Cramerton.

Cramerton also intends to add another short single track trail.

Volunteer work days 4/24 and 5/8, 8 am to 12 pm.

Aiming to reopen park with CTT and Green Zone Trails July 4th weekend while construction on Blue Zone continues
